1. Foreword

Article 18, para. 18.1 of the P-GAS Regulations provides that, to acquire the status of seller, the applicant/Participant shall notify GME of the terms and conditions of supply of natural gas, under the procedures and within the time limits indicated in the Technical Rules.

Article 18, para. 18.5 of the P-GAS Regulations stipulates that, if the selling Participant intends to change the terms and conditions of supply with respect to those previously sent to and published by GME, he/she shall notify GME thereof by sending the new terms and conditions of supply to GME, under the procedures and within the time limits indicated in the Technical Rules.

2. Procedure and time limits to acquire the status of seller

The Participant will acquire the status of seller on the P-GAS by notifying GME of his/her terms and conditions of supply of natural gas quantities.

The terms and conditions of supply must be sent by ordinary mail or courier.

GME will publish the terms and conditions of supply within five working days from receipt thereof and, within the same time limit, it will prepare the selling Participant's order book.

3. Procedures and time limits to change the terms and conditions of supply

If the selling Participant intends to change the terms and conditions of supply with respect to those previously sent to and published by GME, he/she shall send to GME - by ordinary mail or courier - the new terms and conditions of supply.

GME will publish all the received documents on its website within five days from receipt thereof.
