## 1. Foreword

Article 14 of the PCE Rules provides that, under the emergency conditions stated therein, GME shall make the notifications defined in the Technical Rules.

## 2. Communications between GME and Participants under emergency conditions

In the case referred to in article 14, para. 14.1 a) of the PCE Rules, i.e. when GME is unable to receive the requests for recording submitted by Participants due to malfunctioning of its telecommunications systems, GME may postpone the time of close of the sitting, notifying Participants thereof by telephone or fax. If the malfunctioning persists, GME may – after having heard the opinion of and in consultation with Terna - suspend the PCE sitting.

In the case referred to in article 14, para. 14.1 b) of the PCE Rules, i.e. when GME is unable to notify Participants of the completed recordings or of any information related thereto owing to, *inter alia*, malfunctioning of the PCE information system or of GME's telecommunication systems, GME will suspend the sitting, notifying Participants thereof through its website or, possibly, by fax or e-mail.
