

## **Technical Rule no. 09 Rev 01 P-GAS**

(under article 4 of the Regulations of the platform for the trading of bids/offers of natural gas, approved by the Ministry of Economic Development on 23 April 2010, as subsequently amended and supplemented)

## **1. Foreword**

Article 27, para. 27.2, of the P-GAS Regulations provides that, under the emergency conditions referred to in the same Article, GME shall make communications under the procedures defined in the Technical Rules.

## **2. Communications between GME and Participants under emergency conditions**

In the case referred to in Article 27, para. 27.1 a) of the P-GAS Regulations, i.e. if GME is unable to receive bids/offers from Participants owing to malfunctions of telecommunications systems, GME may postpone the time of closing of the P-GAS session, notifying Participants thereof by telephone or fax. If the malfunctions persist, GME will suspend the session, notifying Participants thereof through its website or possibly via fax or e-mail.

In the case of article 27, para. 27.1 b) of the P-GAS Regulations, i.e. if GME is unable to determine the results of one of the P-GAS sessions, GME will suspend the session, notifying Participants thereof through its website or possibly by fax or e-mail.

In the case of article 27, para. 27.1 c) of the P-GAS Regulations, i.e. if GME is unable to notify Participants of the results of one of the P-GAS sessions, GME will suspend the subsequent sessions and possibly also the current session, notifying Participants thereof through its website or possibly by fax or e-mail.
